## RESOLUTION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

### ON A NEW CIVILIZATIONAL ARCHITECTURE FOR LASTING PEACE AND PROSPERITY:

CIVILIZATION INDEX · RIGHTS OF NATURE · A FINANCIAL ARCHITECTURE OF DIGNITY  
ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AS A TECHNOLOGY OF PLANETARY SIGNIFICANCE

## THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

**Recalling** the Universal Declaration of Human Rights of 10 December 1948, in particular Article 25, which guarantees the right to a standard of living adequate for the health and well-being of every person and their family,

**Recalling also** the Charter of the United Nations and the principle of sovereign equality of states,

**Noting** that the existing global monetary system, based on the creation of money through debt and interest, structurally incentivizes infinite growth, inequality, the degradation of nature, and conflict,

**Recognizing** that global debt exceeds 315 trillion dollars, while military expenditure reaches 2,400 billion dollars annually,

**Recognizing also** that technological advances, including artificial intelligence, blockchain, and independent verification systems, make it possible for the first time in history to create a transparent, verified, and equitable system of financing grounded in real civilizational progress,

**Convinced** that lasting peace is only possible when the system financially rewards cooperation, the regeneration of nature, and human dignity, rather than conflict and destruction,

## THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

---

- 1. Proclaims** the right of every human being to Civilizational Dignity as a contemporary development and extension of fundamental human rights, the detailed elaboration of which is set out in Annex VI of this Resolution;
- 2. Decides** to establish the Global Civilization Council as an independent coordination body of limited mandate within the United Nations system, with responsibility for setting CI standards, coordinating the transition including Day K, and overseeing the AI verification system; the Council shall hold no executive authority over the internal affairs of Member States;
- 3. Decides also** to establish the Peace Dividend Fund as an independent financial mechanism operating without interest and on the principle of self-renewal, whose sole purpose is the financing of projects that verifiably raise the Civilization Index;

**4. Declares** that the creation of money through interest is permanently prohibited within the framework of this Resolution; no public or private institution participating in the Kolosveuma system may create, issue, or multiply money through compound or simple interest; all financial compensation shall be based exclusively on fixed service fees or profit-sharing agreements; this prohibition is a foundational and non-derogable principle of the new civilizational architecture;

**5. Decides further** to establish the Global Fund of Dignity as the guardian institution of Civilizational Dignity rights worldwide, responsible for setting minimum global standards, overseeing all National Civilizational Dignity Funds, and holding veto power over national decisions that would undermine the minimum level of Civilizational Dignity;

**6. Adopts** the Civilization Index as a framework global standard for measuring civilizational progress: Nature and Life (40%), Quality of Life (38%), and Civilizational Architecture (22%); detailed specification in Annex I;

**7. Proclaims** artificial intelligence to be a technology of planetary significance and calls for the establishment of an ethical framework and AI Consortium based on the principle of 4/5 consensus, in accordance with Annex V;

**8. Requests** the Secretary-General, within 180 days, to establish an Independent Commission on New Civilizational Architecture (ICNCA) with the mandate to submit comprehensive recommendations to the General Assembly within 18 months;

**9. Invites** all Member States to participate voluntarily in pilot programs for Civilization Index verification in cooperation with WHO, UNESCO, UNEP, and FAO;

**10. Decides** to remain seized of the matter.

## ANNEX I Civilization Index: Framework Standard

The Civilization Index is proposed as the global measurement standard for civilizational achievements, submitted to the Independent Commission for consideration and verification.

*Important note: The proposed weights are not binding — they represent a starting point for global scientific and policy debate. The final weights shall be determined by the Commission through a consultative process.*

### CI Anchor — Individual Country Anchors and the GCBI

Before Day K, every participating country establishes its individual CI anchor from existing public data (UN, WHO, UNESCO, ESA, NASA). The GCBI is the weighted global average of all individual anchors on Day K — the immutable zero point of the entire system, representing the measured civilizational state of the planet at transition. Every subsequent Peace Token represents verified growth in global CI

from this zero point. Two functions: projected growth rate ceiling (lower anchor = higher potential) and investment priorities (categories furthest from target).

### Natural Potential Factor (NPF)

Correction multiplier (range 0.65-1.35) reflecting actual ecological starting conditions — result of decades of policy and practice. Measured through independent international data used as corroborating instruments. Changes only as actual ecological conditions change over time. Cannot be self-reported. Effective  $CI = CI\_base \times NPF$ .



## ANNEX II Rights of Nature: A New Legal Framework

<b>Scale</b>	380,000 inhabitants	Paradox of power — a small country, great legitimacy
<b>Motivation</b>	Direct benefit from CI system	A natural ally of the new architecture

## ANNEX V Artificial Intelligence as a Technology of Planetary Significance

*AI without an ethical framework is nuclear technology without the NPT.*

*The world understood this in 1968 with the atomic bomb. It must understand the same in 2026 with artificial intelligence.*

Role	What AI Does	What AI Does NOT Do
<b>CI Verifier</b>	Collects and verifies 12 CI categories from independent sources	Does not decide on category weights — Commission decides
<b>Anomaly Detector</b>	Detects manipulation attempts	Does not penalize — only reports to arbitration tribunal
<b>Peace Monitor</b>	Tracks CI parameters in conflict zones	Does not designate aggressors — task of UN Council
<b>Transparent Witness</b>	Maintains public record of all verifications on blockchain	Does not manage tokens — mathematics manages
<b>Budget Analyst</b>	Verifies that budgets reflect CI objectives	Does not approve budgets — democratic process approves

### I AI IN THE SERVICE OF ALL

Every AI system in CI verification must be equally accessible to all Member States — without financial barriers.

### II TRANSPARENCY AS AN OBLIGATION

Every verification algorithm must be publicly available. No proprietary algorithms may affect the value of a people's currency.

### III AI DOES NOT REPLACE HUMAN DECISIONS ON VALUES

Which categories enter the CI, and with what weights — decided by the democratic process. AI only verifies.

#### IV PROHIBITION OF WEAPONIZATION

Every AI system commits that it will not be used for military purposes without UN Security Council approval.

#### V THE RIGHT TO UNDERSTANDING

Every citizen whose CI score affects their tokens has the right to understand why — in plain language.

#### VI RECOGNITION OF LIMITATIONS AS A VALUE

Every AI in the CI system must incorporate a mechanism for acknowledging uncertainty and calling for human review when needed.

### ANNEX VI Civilizational Dignity

---

**Civilizational Dignity is the logical continuation and practical realization of Article 25 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (1948).**

**It is not a new ideology — it is the fulfillment of a promise made 77 years ago.**

1. **Proclaims** that Civilizational Dignity represents a contemporary development and extension of fundamental human rights;
2. **Proclaims** that Civilizational Dignity encompasses the right of every person to: a secure home; sufficient clean water, food, and basic energy; basic healthcare; access to quality education; and basic social protection;
3. **Decides** to establish the National Civilizational Dignity Fund (NCDF) in every participating country as a constitutionally independent institution with two financing streams: 25% of Transactional Contribution for pensions and existing social protection, and 100% from the PDF for all new Dignity packages;
4. **Calls upon** all Member States to incorporate Civilizational Dignity into their constitutional and legislative frameworks;
5. **Emphasizes** that the provision of Civilizational Dignity is simultaneously a condition and a goal of full participation in the new civilizational architecture;
7. **Recognizes** that the new financial system provides a sustainable mechanism for financing Civilizational Dignity through Peace Tokens issued exclusively on the basis of verified real-world improvements — without generating new debt.
